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The eye is drawn to a radiant cherry-red colour of good depth. The dream continues thanks to enveloping flavours of anis, alpine strawberries and violets. Energy takes up the running in the mouth. Oscillating between freshness and generosity, the wine's stuffing stretches out to reveal evident yet skilfully enveloped tannin. Grace and voluptuousness are guaranteed!

For an aperitif or with delicate dishes such as a puff pastry tart with goats cheese and courgette flowers, or white meats such as chicken breast with caramelised girolle mushrooms in an onion cream sauce.

Serve between 12°C and 14°C

Drink now or up to 8-10 years old depending on the vintage.
